

How to access TAFE NSW eResources via Google Scholar

Google Scholar is a search engine for scholarly literature. You can use it to find journal articles, theses, books and abstracts. Some of the articles you find through Google Scholar are freely available, while others require you to pay for access.


In many cases you can actually access the “pay” articles for free, via the library’s subscription databases. In order to do this you will need to link Google Scholar to the TAFE NSW eResource collection.

Follow the instructions below to get started.

Please note: you will need to repeat these steps on each device you use to search the web, unless your Google Chrome settings are synchronised. You can learn how to sync your Google account at <https://bit.ly/38JOKit>

STEP 1. Go to **Google Scholar:**

STEP 2. Click on the hamburger menu.







STEP 3. Click on **Settings**. Please note, **Settings** may be listed as the last option on the menu, or as a cog in the right hand corner of the menu.



STEP 4. Click on **Library Links**.



STEP 5. Search for **TAFE NSW**.


STEP 6. Tick the box next to **TAFE NSW Libraries – Find @ TAFE NSW Libraries**, then click **Save**.


Online access to library subscriptions is usually restricted to patrons of that library. You may need to login with your library password, use a campus computer, or configure your browser to use a library proxy. Please visit your library's website or ask a local librarian for assistance.

To retain settings, you must turn on [cookies](#)


STEP 7. Search for articles as usual. Articles available in the TAFE NSW eResource collection will say **Find @ TAFE NSW Libraries**. Click on the link for access.



STEP 8. Log-in with your TAFE NSW username and password.




STEP 9. The **Full Text Finder Results** page will appear listing all the links to the specific article. There may be more than one link because the article may be available in more than one database. Click on a link to access the article.



STEP 10. Click here to continue.



STEP 11. You will be taken to the article information page. Look for the **full text** link to read the whole article.
