

How to access TAFE NSW eResources via Google Scholar

Google Scholar is a search engine for scholarly literature. You can use it to find journal articles, theses, books and abstracts. Some of the articles you find through Google Scholar are freely available, while others require you to pay for access.

In many cases you can actually access the "pay" articles for free, via the library's subscription databases. In order to do this you will need to link Google Scholar to the TAFE NSW eResource collection.

Follow the instructions below to get started.

Please note: you will need to repeat these steps on each device you use to search the web, unless your Google Chrome settings are synchronised. You can learn how to sync your Google account at <u>https://bit.ly/38JOKit</u>

STEP 1. Go to **Google Scholar**: https://scholar.google.com.au/
