The Standard Operating Procedures (SOPS) are located on the **Welcome** page of each guide. Click on the link in the box.



### HOW TO VIEW A STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOPS)

1. Select the subject you require by clicking on the title link eg: Dogs and Cats.

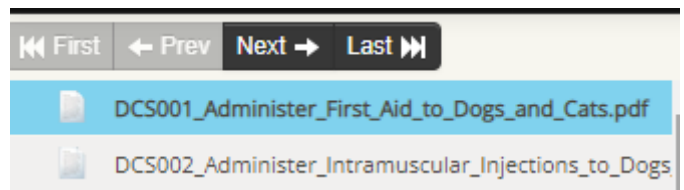

2. Log in to Learning Bank with your **TAFE username and password** eg john.smith12

3. This will show you the SOPs for Dogs and Cats. Navigate between the different SOPs by the menu on the left of screen. To navigate between different SOPs, select First, Prev, Next or Last OR you can click on the SOP title from the list.



4. A pdf of the SOP will appear on screen. Here you will have the option to print and download. Select from the available icons on the top right of screen. Library staff are able to assist you with printing.



5. To return to the SOPs topic list page, you will need to close the open tab by clicking on the X OR select the correct tab on the left.
